- God can use a pandemic to serve his purpose and strengthen His people.
- All things work together for good for God's people. See Romans 8:28
- And not only that, but we glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our heart by the Holy Spirit . . . Romans 5:3-5

God's Gift of Struggle . . .

- Don't just GO THROUGH the difficulty, adversity and the storm
 - GROW THROUGH THEM!
 - Strength/Power
 - Endurance
 - Hope and Experience

Even in the pandemic . . .

- Stay Faithful
- Stay Focused
- Stay Engaged & Hungry
- Stay Woke

I. STAY FAITHFUL

As the Lord wrote to the church at Smyrna, [b]e faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. Revelation 2:10

A life in the Lord does not exempt us from trouble, trials and tribulation. However, the Lord expects His to remain faithful.

As Paul concluded his First Missionary work, ha and Barnabas resolved that "we must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God." Acts 14:22

One of Israel's Flaws

- Persistently doubting God when a little turbulence, challenge and trouble appeared – which demonstrated little faith!
- However, a FAITHFUL LIFE is demonstrated by trusting in Him and living in eager and unwavering anticipation of the Lord's deliverance.

II. STAY FOCUSED

- Keep your eyes on the prize!!
- I woke up this morning with my mind, it was staid on Jesus!

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; ² But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. ³ He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper. Psalm 1:1-3

Our focus must be even more laser-like, one-track now.

Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made . . . Genesis 3:1

In the midst of difficulty, struggle and pandemic even, Satan works to consume us in doubt, fear and worry and attempts to deceive us into thinking God has forsaken and does not care about us!

- Satan also tries to lead us into a downward spiral of hopelessness, stress and depression.
- Liquor consumption is up during the pandemic; substance abuse experts are concerned.

IV. Stay Woke

- Washington Irving wrote about a fellow who left the house one day after he felt his wife nagged him too much.
- He retreated to the Catskill mountains with his musket and his dog, Wolf.
- Sees a band of men and joins them in a round of drinking.
- He falls asleep.
- He awakens, with a rusty, dilapidated musket, Wolf was nowhere to be found, and his beard was snow white and 1.5 feet long.

- He ventures into town and doesn't recognize anyone or the surroundings.
- He tells the townfolks that he is forever loyal to King George III, which almost gets him hanged.
- An old lady recognizes him as the longlost Rip Van Winkle.
- At one of his favorite hangouts, the portrait of King George III had been replaced by that of George Washington.
- Mr. Van Winkle had not only slept 20 years, he had literally slept through a revolution.
