## BEING ACCEPTED & ASCENDING Acts 10:27-35

### **BACKDROP**

 On brink of God's fulfilling promise made to Abraham many centuries before . . .

"By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you [Abraham] have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son . . . In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice." Genesis 22:16, 18

### **BACKDROP**

- Cornelius' work had been noticed by God.
  - Feared God with "all" his household;
  - Gave alms generously to the people;
  - Prayed to God always. Acts 10:2
  - Angel told him that his prayers and alms had come up for a memorial

Yet Cornelius was undone (in an unacceptable state) before God. . .

"Now send men to Joppa, and send for Simon whose surname is Peter. He is lodging with Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the sea. He will tell you what you must do." Acts 10:6-7

#### Please note . . .

- Our works alone won't cut it grossly inadequate to get us into heaven. Isa. 64:6
- Faithful obedience has always been the ticket

   dating all the way back to antediluvian days
   (the Great Flood & Noah's time).
- The midnight vision won't get the job done. The road to conversion leads through the word being preached. Romans10:10-14

Cornelius' coming to Peter, demystifies his (Peter's) vision (Acts 10:9–17) --

Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him." Acts 10:34-35

- God accepts everyone who does his blessed commands.
- I am so happy about this.
- God's acceptance of us is not dependent on someone else's opinion – a subjective assessment that may be laced with bias, improper or impure motive, or unforgiving spirit!
- We don't have to be from the right side of town or from a lineage of royalty.

### God's Message to Cain

And the LORD said to Cain, "Why are you so angry? And why do you look annoyed? If you do well [believing Me and doing what is acceptable and pleasing to Me], will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well [but ignore My instruction], sin crouches at your door; its desire is for you [to overpower you], but you must master it." Genesis 4:6-7 AMP

### The message in fairly layman terms -

If you want honor, recognition and advancement . . .

- Find out (learn) what you need to do;
- Practice and perfect it;
- Produce and perform at the appointed time (i.e., BE OBEDIENT).

# Instead of subduing sin, Cain allowed sin to get the upper hand.

Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him. Genesis 4:8

- Failure to do what we can or know to do can put sin at our door when we see others rising and flourishing.
  - Envy & jealousy
  - Hatred
  - Slander
  - Discontentment
  - Strife & division
- Produces works of the flesh & does not yield fruit of the spirit! See Galatians 5:19-23

Praise and notoriety come after we have endured and accomplished missions.

Not flippantly thrown about . . .

Trophy generation beware . . . Everyone gets awarded a prize/medal.

- Creating an environment where excellence may be disincentivized.
- Many times people want to be praised and exalted when their actions and performance haven't warranted it.
- Many live entitled: SIMPLY BECAUSE I'M HERE OR SHOW UP, I should be esteemed and honored.
- This attitude is rampant; it serves to stunt growth and real development.

# Paul correcting the Corinthians' disorder at the Lord's supper . . .

Now in giving these instructions I do not praise you, since you come together not for the better but for the worse.... What! Do you not have houses to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God and shame those who have nothing? What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you in this? I do not praise you. I Corinthians 11:17, 22

## Recall the parable of "The Talents" (Matthew 25:14-30)

- The Lord (Master) commended and rewarded the servants who were productive. Matthew 25:21, 23
  - "Well done, good and faithful servant..."
- The Lord (Master) was greatly displeased with the servant who returned what he was given the single talent! Matthew 25:26
  - "You wicked and lazy servant . . ."



Do you know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. I Corinthians 9:24
