BACKDROP

- Paul's destruction had been an object of the Jews since the beginning of his conversion because he immediately became a witness for the Lord. **Acts 9:20, 23**
- His 180° turn confounded the Jews at Damascus. Acts 9:21
- At Ptolemais, Paul defied the counsel of Luke, Agabus and others to not return to Jerusalem. Acts 21:7-14
- When he returned to Jerusalem, Paul was seized, dragged out of the temple, and was being beaten in an attempt to kill him.
 Acts 21:30-31
- Commander of the garrison and soldiers took Paul into custody by putting him into the barracks. **Acts 21:32-35**

- Recall that the Jews' chief complaint was that Paul was teaching contrary to Moses and the Law.
- Paul provides his defense at Jerusalem (to the Jews). Acts 22:1-21
- The Lord stood by Paul and told him he would bear witness of Him at Rome. Acts 23:11
- Plot (by more than 40 men) on Paul's life quelled after his nephew hears of the Jews' planned ambush. Acts 23:12-35
- Ananias the high priest through Tertullus, the orator, called Paul a plague, who created dissension among all the Jews throughout the world and was a ringleader of a sect of the Nazarenes. Acts 24:2-5
- When appearing before Festus (the governor), Paul appealed his case to Caesar. Acts 25:10-12
- En route to Rome, Paul would become shipwrecked at Malta, where he was bitten by a viper (snake), but suffered no harm. Acts 27:39-28:6

In today's text . . .

• The Apostle Paul presents the Jews at Jerusalem with the gospel – they could either accept it or reject it. **Act 28:23**

 Like many situations, some will accept what's right, pure, or expedient; while others will reject the same. Acts 28:24 • So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at his lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening. ²⁴ And some were persuaded by the things which were spoken, and some disbelieved. ²⁵ So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed after Paul had said one word: "The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet to our fathers, ²⁶ saying, 'Go to this people and say: "Hearing you will hear, and shall not understand; And seeing you will see, and not perceive; ²⁷ For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, And their eyes they have closed, Lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, Lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, So that I should heal them."' Acts 28:23-27

Two Officials Blow It by ... 1. <u>Awaiting a Convenient Time</u>

And after some days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, who was Jewish, he sent for Paul and heard him concerning the faith in Christ. ²⁵ Now as he reasoned about righteousness, self-control, and the judgment to come, Felix was afraid and answered, "Go away for now; when I have a convenient time I will call for you." Acts 24:24-25

- We often do not have the luxury of waiting for a more convenient time; now is the time to act.
- Carpe diem → "Sieze the day (moment)." See Acts 8:34-39 (Ethiopian eunuch seized the opportunity)

2. Being Indecisive (Waffling)

• ²⁶ For the king, before whom I also speak freely, knows these things; for I am convinced that none of these things escapes his attention, since this thing was not done in a corner. ²⁷ King Agrippa, do you believe the prophets? I know that you do believe." ²⁸ Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You almost persuade me to become a Christian."²⁹ And Paul said, "I would to God that not only you, but also all who hear me today, might become both almost and altogether such as I am, except for these chains." Acts 26:26-29

Mountain Mayhem . . .

And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. ²² Then said Elijah unto the people, I, even I only, remain a prophet of the LORD; but Baal's prophets are four hundred and fifty men... I Kings 18:21 ff.
