EXPECTATION-DRIVEN FAITH 2 KINGS 7:1-2, 16-20

Then Elisha said, "Hear the word of the LORD." Thus says the LORD: 'Tomorrow about this time a seah of fine flour shall be sold for a shekel, and two seahs of barley for a shekel, at the gate of Samaria.' "So an officer on whose hand the king leaned answered the man of God and said, "Look, if the LORD would make windows in heaven, could this thing be?" And he said, "In fact, you shall see it with your eyes, but you shall not eat of it." II Kings 7:1-2 (emphasis added)

Initial Points

- II Kings is the focus of Bible Bowl 2020.
- Hopefully, scholars have started to reading the materials.
- Work the Works! (while it is yet day, for the night cometh when no one can work).
- Il Kings provides a cautionary tale of what happens when God's people rebel and continuously reject Him.
 - Israel (Northern Kingdom) overtaken by Assyrians --II Kings 17:1-6 (Shelmaneser -> Hoshea)
 - Judah (Southern Kingdom) taken captive by Babylonians – II Kings 25 (Nebuchadnezzar -> Zedekiah)

- Today's lesson text is a continuation of events from II Kings 6.
- The Syrians, led by Ben-Hadad, had besieged Samaria (the capital of Israel). Il Kings 6:24
- Supplies cut off, and great famine in the land.
 - Donkey's head sold for 80 shekels of silver;
 - One-fourth of a kab of dove droppings going for five shekels of silver. II Kings 6:25
 - People resorted to cannibalism. II Kings 6:26-29
- King of Israel blamed Elisha. See II Kings 6:30-31

Attitude in times of difficulty, struggle, challenge, & ordeals --

- Do you have an expectancy of success and endurance?
- Do you focus on the size of the problem or the MAGNITUDE OF GOD? See II Kings 6:16
- Remember, God ---
 - Is true (Romans 3:4, Psalm 84:1);
 - Is faithful (Psalm 37:25, II Peter 3:9);
 - Cares for you (I Peter 5:7);
 - Works all things out for the good of His children (Romans 8:28).

Healthy Expectations -> Solid Faith

Should prompt us to move. James 2:14, 18

Lord, I really do not know **how** this is going to happen, but I am trusting and believing in YOU that it will come to pass.

- Math is not my forte, but I need calculus to get this degree.
- If I am accepted to this school, how am I going to fund it?
- These people are rebellious and stiff-necked, how can I possibly minister to them?

SURELY ENOUGH ->

Now the king had appointed the officer on whose hand he leaned to have charge of the gate. But the people trampled him in the gate, and he died, just as the man of God had said, who spoke when the king came down to him. 18 So it happened just as the man of God had spoken to the king, saying, "Two seahs of barley for a shekel, and a seah of fine flour for a shekel, shall be sold tomorrow about this time in the gate of Samaria." 19 Then that officer had answered the man of God, and said, "Now look, if the LORD would make windows in heaven, could such a thing be?" And he had said, "In fact, you shall see it with your eyes, but you shall not eat of it." 20 And so it happened to him, for the people trampled him in the gate, and he died.
