Many like to note that in the beginning Job had it all (1:2-3), lost it, and gained it all back (42:12-15).

- Beautiful family seven sons, three daughters
- Prosperity 7,000 (14,000) sheep, 3,000 (6,000) camels, 500 (1,000) yoke of oxen, 500 (1,000) female donkeys
- Many servants and persons who waited on him great household
- Influence and notoriety "greatest of all the people of the East"

But what made Job who he was had precious little to do with his material blessings.

They certainly did not necessarily score any points with God.

- Blameless and upright (1:1);
- Feared GOD (1:1);
- Eschewed (shunned) evil (1:1);
- Held fast to his integrity, despite the maladies and opposition (2:9-10);
- Committed to the spiritual best interests of his children (1:5).
