#3 The More We Have The More We Worry, Verse 12

"The sleep of a laboring man is sweet,
Whether he eats little or much;
But the abundance of the rich will not permit him to sleep."

- Solomon has observed that people who work hard and take care of themselves and their families with the basic necessities sleep well!
- The wealthy man has too much going on in his life to worry about and doesn't sleep well (can't unwind)
- <u>"Things"</u> don't bring peace but more anxiety
- The rich worry about losing their wealth, and not being "content with such things as you have....." Hebrews 13:5

Much Of The Tension In Our Culture Is Due To Worry Over Money!

What is the Stock Market Doing?

How is my 401K?

How are sales being affected by the economy?

Do my kids have enough money for college?

What will the I.R.S. gouge me with this year?

How can I get rid of people I don't want?

Do You Remember The Term AFFLUENZA?

A socially transmitted condition of overload, debt, anxiety, and waste, resulting from the relentless pursuit of MORE

The "Affluenza Defense"- used to defend a 16 year old boy in Texas whose drunk driving one night killed 4 people and injured 9.

The defense argued that this boy was brought up in an environment of wealth and privilege, in which his parents did not place a limit on his behavior, and that he did not know that his actions had consequences.

Observations

- Researchers in Australia posed the question, "If the economy has been doing so well, why are we not becoming happier?"
- Their argument is that affluenza causes overconsumption, "luxury fever", consumer debt, overwork, waste, and harm to a human being's emotional environment.
- Their conclusion is that these pressures lead to "psychological disorders, alienation, and distress", causing people to "self medicate with mood altering drugs and excessive alcohol consumption."
- The Researchers, who studied Australia, now believe that "Downshifting" is a reaction by many Australians to "Affluenza"- Reduce their income, and place family, friends and contentment above money in determining their "life goals."

Symptoms of "Affluenza"

- An inability to delay gratification and tolerate frustration
- A false sense of entitlement
- Loss of future motivation
- Preoccupation with the externals
- Excessive materialism and consumerism

Jesus Addressed "Affluenza"

"Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist on the abundance of things he possesses." Luke 12:15

- Life (the good life) is not defined by what you have, or how much you own
- Being rich toward God is living "the good life"
- Work hard and learn contentment with what you have
- Paul teaches that each one should "bear his own load." Galatians 6:5




