BACKDROP

- Church (with its start in Jerusalem) is experiencing phenomenal growth
 - + 3,000 added on day of Pentecost (Acts 2:41);
 - + 5,000 men (Acts 4:4);
 - + Believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women ... (Acts 5:14).

But not everyone was thrilled about the impact and success of the Lord's church.

NOTICE THE VISCERAL REACTION (HATE)

- Chief priests and elders: But so that it spreads no further among the people, let us severely threaten them, that from now on they speak to no man in this name. Acts 4:17 (Response: Acts 4:29-30 – prayer for boldness)
- Apostles imprisoned by high priest and Sadducees. Acts 5:17-18
- Apostles beaten and commanded again not to speak in Jesus' name. Acts 5:40
- Stephen's stoning. Acts 7:54-60


After Stephen delivers a resounding message that succinctly covers the history of Israel and ends with an "indictment" of the Jews for their complicity in the betrayal and murder of the "Just One" (Christ), he is killed. Acts 7

× From all appearances, the disciples were comfortable and content in Jerusalem.

Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need. Acts 4:32-35

- Sut the plan was never for the Word to be confined exclusively to Jerusalem
- × Persecution proved an effective impetus.
- Many times, we become satisfied, comfortable and complacent.
- × We lose drive and motivation.
- **×** Growth becomes stagnant.
- We need a little something to get us going -to be where we should.

God understands a little something abut human nature, and our response to stimuli.

After all . . . He made us!

Often, we have to be pushed to move beyond our COMFORT ZONE. Even with that many of us move kicking, screaming, hollering & complaining!
