NO BUYER'S REMORSE WITH THE LORD!

- ✘ Many times purchasers experience what we call “buyer’s remorse.”
- ✘ Sense of regret after having made a purchase, usually when one feels that s/he paid too much.
- ✘ Not so with the Lord!
- ✘ The price was high, but the Lord experienced no BM!

THE PROOF!

- ✘ *I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.*
Luke 15:7

- ✘ *Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”* **Luke 15:10**

REMEMBER, THE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS IN LIFE AREN'T THINGS

- ✘ Growing up with a number of brothers and sisters, the Christmas holiday season was always special.
- ✘ We always expressed what we wanted, but often they were simply a wish.
- ✘ We were often reminded that it is the thought that counts, and there are some things \$\$\$ cannot purchase.

What they taught and instilled in us were way more important than things.

Things –

- Perish with using

- Are lost or stolen

- Become damaged

- Depreciate

- Bring temporary contentment/happiness

- Can be a hindrance to spiritual growth

RECALL THE STORY OF THE RICH RULER (MARK 10:17-25)

- ✘ The Lord's encounter with this young man begins with a sincere question?
 - + “Good teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?” v. 17
- ✘ Tragically, the story ends with the fellow departing disappointed and sorrowful.
 - + He did not want to part with his material goods. See vv. 21-22
 - + Begs the question – Is the possession of material goods a blessing or a curse?

SEVERAL MORE OBSERVATIONS

- ✘ Christ told the young man that he knew scriptures (Ten Commandments) See **Mark 10:19**
- ✘ The young man appeared to feel confident and good about himself – “All these things have I kept from my youth.” **Mark 10:20**
- ✘ Sometimes its easy to get it right in some areas, but in other areas we struggle

✘ Important Matters

+ Discipline/temperance – See Proverbs 25:28

+ Perseverance – See Galatians 6:9

+ Work ethic – See Ecclesiastes 9:10

+ Compassion – See Proverbs 19:17

+ Relationship with the Lord

✘ *For what will it profit a man if gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul. Mark 8:37*

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting on the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. Colossians 3:1-2
