BACKDROP

Notice what Solomon has observed more than once.

- Something that has resonated with him caught his attention and had him awe-struck.
- It's not like many of his other points that he begins or concludes that this (too) is "vanity."
- This **wisdom** I have also seen under the sun, and it seemed great to me. **Proverbs 9:13**

BACKDROP CONT'D

A little city with few men in it was besieged by a great king (with abundant resources, power and influence) and made it difficult for the residents to conduct life.

Imprisoned it – nothing could get in and nothing went out.

Would seem that all was lost.

The odds simply were not in the small city's favor at all, which makes sense from a human perspective.

- Many times we find ourselves in THE STRUGGLE, facing seemingly insurmountable odds and wondering how we are going to get over the hump!
- Competing with those who have more resources, who grew up with the proverbial "silver spoon" in their mouths.
- * However, one poor citizen, who exercised wisdom, delivered the city.
- Sadly, they forgot all about this man and his valiance.

Solomon surmised three things after noticing people outlast and overcome the giants in their lives.

1. Wisdom Provides a Decisive Advantage

"Wisdom is better than strength" and "weapons of war." Proverbs 9:16, 18

He who trusts in his own heart is a fool, but whoever walks wisely will be delivered. **Proverbs 28:26**

2.Foolish, Loud Talk Means Nothing, Irrespective of Who Voices It

Words of the wise, spoken quietly, should be heard rather than the shout of a ruler of fools. Ecclesiastes 9:17

Many think that just because they talk loud they have something worth listening to – "NOT SO," says Solomon.

Many think that just because someone of "importance" says something, it is worth listening to — "NOT SO," says Solomon.

We should carefully consider and weigh what we are told. **See Acts 17:11**

3. People Often Reject What's Best

Nevertheless the poor man's wisdom is despised, and his words are not heard. Ecclesiastes 9:16

Wisdom, which is of God, not heard or hearkened to and treated like dung.

For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding. He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly; He guards the paths of justice, and He preserves the way of His saints. **Proverbs 2:6-8**
